



We would like to welcome you and thank you for allowing us to provide quality care for your child. In this stage of your child's life we will continue to reinforce and review ideas and concepts that we have been focusing on.

They include:

- Counting and recognizing numbers. We focus on numbers 1 to 20, but we also allow them to go as far as they can in learning.
- Reciting and recognizing ABC's
- Recognizing colors and shapes
- Nutrition and health
- Music and Movement
- Beginning writing skills (hold pencil and crayon)
- Social Skills (sharing, getting along with others, conflict resolution, field trips, etc.)
- Foreign language

In this class we will enhance your child's listening skills with daily stories. We will focus on following directions and the class rules. Centers are provided so that the children can learn through play and express themselves through interaction and role playing.

We will have outside time daily—weather permitting. Please dress your child in weather-appropriate clothing and clothing you do not mind getting soiled.

We also take field trips and observe most holidays in this class. Please feel free to participate in any aspect of the class room.



Helpful Reminders

For all field trips, there will be permission slip that has to be filled out and signed before your child can leave the premises. When we have field trips, we will let you know in advance so you can decide if you would like to chaperone.

Medicine

A medicine form (located in the front lobby) must be filled out before we can administer any medication. If needed, please fill out and give it and medication to the teacher or director.

What your child needs:

- Box of tissue
- Small bottle of Anti-bacterial soap
- Blanket (which is taken home every Friday to be washed & returned Monday)
- Two changes of seasonal clothing, including socks
- Book bag
- Family picture

Please be sure to check your child's cubby daily for soiled clothing.

Please do not dress your child in belts or clothing that is hard for them to remove during potty time.
