



Congratulations! Your child is either reached a major milestone before turning two years old or has turned two years old. We would like to welcome you and thank you for allowing us to provide quality child care for your child.

This class will be geared towards more social and cognitive skills. We will cover reciting numbers consecutively. We will focus on the alphabet, primary colors, shapes and a few of our zoo friends. We will enhance your child's listening skills along with following directions. The classroom setting is structured to better prepare your child for the next class they will be moving to.

Emphasis will be put on large and small motor skills. Daily story time will enhance listening skills and center time will enhance learning through play. We will introduce crayons and using art supplies when your child is developmentally ready.

This class is also designated to introduce your child to the potty. If you are not ready for your child to be potty trained, please let us know. To successfully help your child, we will need to work closely with you on the method or approach you are using at home. We prefer to use the method that you have chosen, so that the child is not confused while transitioning. Please feel free to participate in any aspect of the class. We welcome you to drop in at anytime. We realize that every child is different and learn at their own pace. We will introduce ideas and different learning concepts as each child is developmentally ready.



Helpful Reminders

A medicine form (located in the front lobby area) is needed before we can administer any medications, diaper ointments or any form of first aid. This is a DSS regulation.

We will continue to use sippy cups in this class. However, we will also introduce them to drinking from a cup. This will also help with their gross motor skills.

What your child will need:

- Pull-ups
- Box of tissue
- Hand sanitizer
- Sippy cup
- 6 large bibs
- A blanket (they should be taken home on Fridays, washed and returned on Mondays)

Two changes of seasonal clothing.

Three changes of seasonal clothing if your child is transitioning to underwear.

Your child's clothing should consist of 2- 3 set of the following:
shirt, pants, underwear & socks

Please be sure to check your child's cubby daily for soiled clothing.

Please do not dress your child in onesies or belts. These items make it very hard for your child to potty without accidents .

We are with your child during the most active time of the day. We would like to partner with you so that together we can make their daily learning experiences fun, as well as educational.
